Be Content

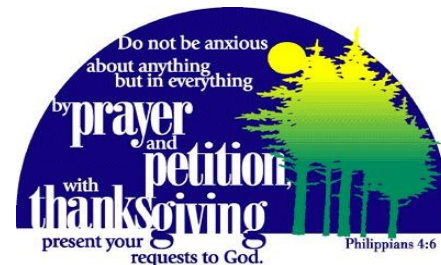
