approximately sixty grains on each stalk. There will always be an even number of grains.

Beans grow up a pole from left to right, while the morning glory grows up a pole from right to left. If turned upside down, “twining” plants will uncoil and recircle their support. Guide a twiner in the “wrong”


direction, and the plant will rewind itself. The higher a twiner grows, the more tightly it clasps its support.¹

The dandelion will grow above its surroundings whether the grass be two, ten, or twenty inches, for it must get up into the sunlight. An ordinary watermelon will have ten stripes on it. Larger ones may have twelve to sixteen stripes, but always an even number.
