Today marks the beginning of our Annual Gospel Meeting. The theme for this occasion is: "Revive Us Again" selected from Psalm 85:6.

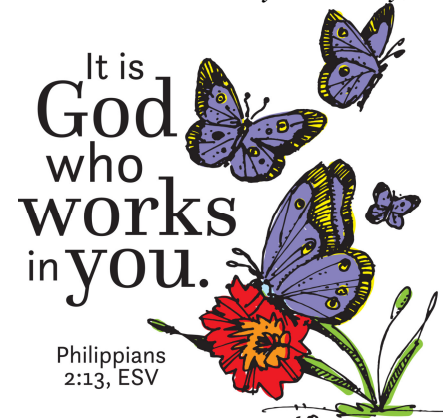
