From the Minister's Desk; Agree to Disagree? (Part 1)

How many times have you heard two people, who cannot come to an agreement on a particular subject, say; "well, we just agree to disagree." This phrase has become very common in the religious arena. Many say it doesn't matter what we believe and practice in religion, as long as we all love Jesus and recognize him to be the Son of God. While it is important to love the Lord, the logical question is "how is our love for the Lord demonstrated?" Jesus said, "if you love me, Keep my commandments" (John 14:15). On another occasion Jesus asked the question; "why call ye me Lord, Lord, and do not the things that I say?" (Luke 6:46). If we truly love the Lord, we will seek to know, obey and teach his word.

To "Agree to Disagree" completely removes the importance of the word of God. This indifferent approach to the Bible is claimed by some to be the solution to the religious division that is glaringly apparent in the world today.
