From the Minister's Desk; What Does It Mean to Believe in Jesus?

(Part 2)

To believe in Jesus is to trust and do everything Jesus and His inspired word says and for the reason He says. To believe in Jesus is to obey Him when He says, "He that believes and is baptized shall be saved" (Mark 16:16). One needs help to misunderstand this.
