### Remembering God's Blessings

PSALM 9 :1-2

(A Message from the Elders)

We are given amazing blessings when we trust in God. Recalling these promises is a good way to maintain a thankful heart, even when facing challenges in other areas. Consider four such blessings:

1. Christ's gift of salvation. No matter what trial we're facing, it is very small next to the enormity of Jesus' sacrifice on our behalf. The cross was a steep price to pay, but the Savior willingly took our place in order to offer us forgiveness and eternal life.

2. Assurance of God's love. The Lord cares for us unconditionally, that is His very nature (1 John 4:16). Unfortunately, the storms of life can cause us to question this, but Romans

8:31-39 tells us nothing can separate us from the love of God.

3. Answered prayer. We have the awesome privilege of talking to the Father about anything burdening us and He never grows tired of listening to His children. God is not only able to help us in any situation; He also knows the best possible way to do so.
